**RULES AND REQUIREMENTS TO BE AN ACTIVE AND PRODUCTIVE
MEMBER OF THE BOY SCOUTS TROOP 147**

1. No name calling.
2. No bad language.
3. No touching, fighting, hitting
4. No smoking, drugs, alcohol—#4 *MAJOR OFFENSE*
5. Tents are for sleeping only, no food or drinks in tents. Do not go into someone's Tent unless invited. Do not tamper with anyone's tent or gear.
6. The scout or scouts responsible will pay for damage to troop or another individual's property. Parents will be notified.
7. Scouts must stay with the troop or group during any scout activity—#7 *MAJOR OFFENSE*
8. Scouts are expected to live and abide by the Scout Law and Scout Oath at all times including school, home, meetings and public locations.

***Being a member of the Boy Scouts is a 'PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT'. We will NOT, allow any scout to disrupt the scouting experience for others in the Troop.**

Breaking any rule will result in the following:

First time: Verbal warning

Second time: Verbal warning and a call to parents

Third time: Suspension from troop activities for a time as determined by the Green Bar. If this occurs on a campout the parents will be called to come pick up the scout.

Major Offense : If a scout breaks rule #4 or #7 or any rule set by an adult. The Scout will be sent home with an immediate suspension, if on a campout the parent will be called to come and pick the scout up. The Green Bar will determine suspension length.

OTHER:

Scouts are required to attend 80% of the Troop Meetings to be eligible for Camp and Troop activities.

Scouts that are below the 80% will not be considered for Leadership positions.

Scouts should inform their Patrol Leaders if unable to attend a meeting/activity.

Scouts in Junior Leadership Positions are expected to attend 100% of meetings and activities. All reasons must be valid and a call should be made to the Scoutmaster.

Every scout is expected to have a parent registered with the troop.

We have read the Rules and Requirements of Troop 147 and fully understand what is expected and required to be an active and productive member.
